





TOTAL KNEE REPLACEMENT (TKR) CAMP AT AHRC-AIMS BY AIMS ALUMNI




A Transformative Initiative in

Addressing the Growing Burden of Knee Problems

Knee pain and degenerative joint diseases have become a significant health concern among the rural and economically weaker populations. Limited access to specialized orthopaedic care often results in prolonged disability, reduced mobility, and compromised livelihood. Recognizing this challenge, AHRC-AIMS envisioned the TKR camp as a platform to deliver **advanced surgical care**, restore mobility, and improve quality of life—**free of cost or at highly subsidized rates** for deserving patients.

Camp Statistics & Performance

The camp witnessed enthusiastic participation and significant clinical impact:

- **Total Registrations: 128**
- **Total Knee Replacement Surgeries Performed: 85**
 - Right Knee: 46
 - Left Knee: 39
- **Gender Distribution:**
 - Male Patients: 39
 - Female Patients: 46

A Record-Breaking Achievement

A remarkable milestone was achieved during the camp when **Dr. T. N. Balakrishna Gowda performed 31 Total Knee Replacement surgeries in a single day**, setting a new record and demonstrating outstanding surgical efficiency and expertise. This accomplishment reflects both the skill of the surgeon and the robust support of the AHRC orthopaedic, anaesthesia, nursing, and rehabilitation teams.

Impact on Rural and Economically Weaker Communities

The TKR camp stands as a testament to AHRC's commitment to **uplifting underserved populations**. For many beneficiaries, knee replacement surgery was previously unaffordable or inaccessible. Through this initiative:
